How to know Bales are Certified Weed Seed Free Forage

Certified bales will have:

1. A white certification tag attached to each bale.
2. A transit certificate. Bales produced and delivered in Iowa may be issued a transit certificate to accompany the bales in place of tags.
3. Bales from out-of-state can have tags or twine. The twine is a special purple and yellow twine used to bind the bale. A transit certificate may accompany these bales.


Information not certifying bales includes:

1. A field inspection certificate. This form only indicates the field was inspected; it does not certify the bales or verify a field meets requirements.
2. A tag request form.
3. Producer's name on the Iowa Crop website showing they are a producer.
